- Nice to have range of lengths to have some flexibility
- Want them to have confidence when going outdoors - Big drop - Partly because when they go outdoors they cannot hit 50m and beyond
- Reasonable amount left for other stuff
- Beginner's equipment for next year: Arm guards Eleanor made not as popular?

- Stringers for next year - Get ones easier for people to use - The ones with strap
